

# Pansar donates safety shower, eyewash systems to healthcare facilities

**SIBU:** Pansar Berhad has donated nine units of Enware safety shower and eyewash systems to several healthcare institutions in Sarawak.

The recipients are Sibu Hospital, Sibu Jaya Health Clinic, Oya Health Clinic, Selangau Health Clinic, and Sarawak Heart Centre in Kuching.

The donation, with an estimated market value of RM48,960, marks Pansar Berhad's first contribution of safety equipment to healthcare institutions in the state.
